Huslia Tribal Council: RESOLUTION IN OPPOSITION OF THE PROPOSED AMBLER MINING ROAD

WHEREAS, The Huslia Tribal Council (HTC) is the governing body of the Native Village of Huslia and is federally recognized as a tribe, and

WHEREAS, It is in the best interest of the Huslia Tribal Council to preserve our land, cultures, and peoples, and

WHEREAS, The proposed road to Ambler would put preserving the land at fault, and

WHEREAS, Our subsistence resources are our guarantee of life into future generations and would be greatly affected by the proposed road, and

WHEREAS, We have an inherent right to that subsistence, and

WHEREAS, We have been successful stewards of this environment and these subsistence resources for thousands of years, and

WHEREAS, Building the road will require using asbestos-laden soil and sulfide materials which will create acid and pollute our land, water, and air, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

The Huslia Tribal Council opposes the building of the proposed road to the Ambler Mining District.
